



Prep Your Dog For a Photo Shoot

When and Where:

- Call to check if dogs & professional photography are allowed on grounds
- Location is temperature appropriate for dog's size and coat

Protect Your Dog:

- Up to date on all necessary vaccinations
- Currently on flea and tick preventative medications

Talk to Your Photographer:

Discuss your dog's temperament with your photographer. Let them know how your dog likes and doesn't like being handled.

Before Your Session:

- Practice sit, stay and watch commands 1-2 weeks before photo session
- Book grooming appointments 1-2 days before photo session
- Walk your dog 1-2 hours before photo session

What to Bring:

- Outfits or costumes: Make sure they fit well and won't overheat the dog
- Bandanas or scarves to cover collars
- Special items: beloved blanket, favorite toy, any props you want included
- Bottle of water and travel bowl
- Treats
- Tons and tons of patience! Your dog can tell if you're frustrated, so stay calm and positive during the session!
